

Enrollment Up for 2006 - 2007

At the time of writing, school wide enrollment had reached 2,529 for classes from prep reception through to 12th grade. Up until this date the Admissions office had received and processed 868 applicants for semester one enrollment and from that group, 501 new students had eventually joined our community for this school year.

Our intercultural mix of students from 59 countries that is indicated in the accompanying pie-chart and nationality count is also reflected in our faculty. There are twenty-three nationalities within our teaching staff of more

than 260. This melting pot of population and cultures is one of our strongest features in the JIS community.

During one of our recent professional development days, High School teachers Vivek Bammi and Stephane Thos presented a workshop that focused on our host country students at JIS. Vivek and Stephane elaborated on research and interviews that they conducted among our Indonesian students and parents.

Overwhelmingly, the results of their inquiries indicated that our host country students are enthusiastically embracing the challenges of the JIS academic and co-curricular programs.

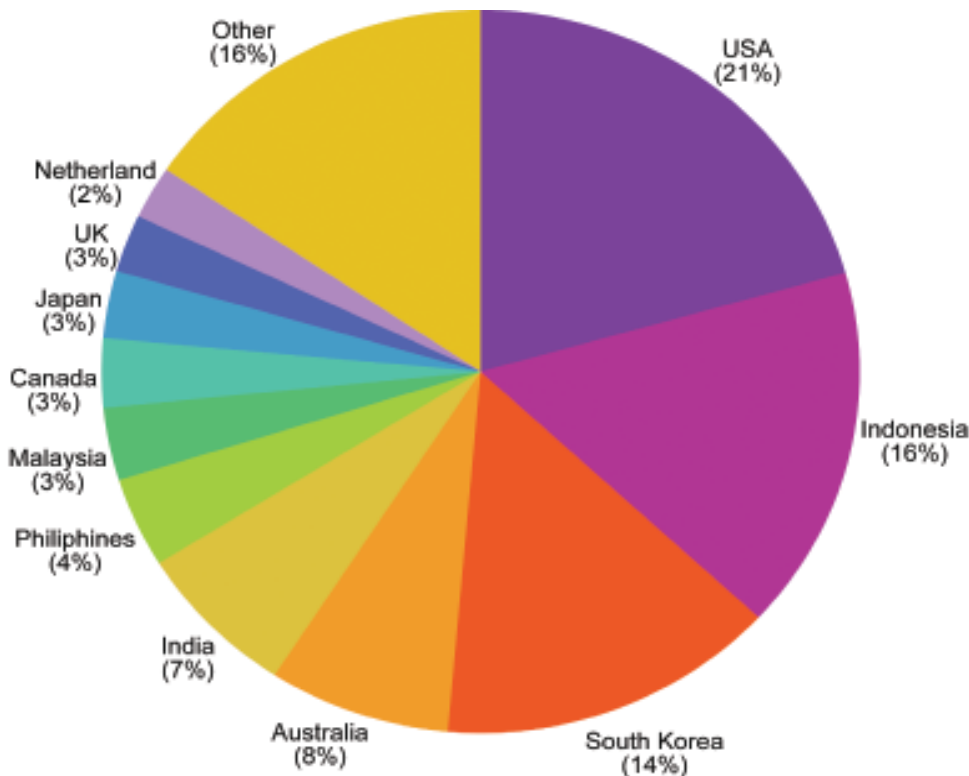
Perhaps just as important, these students are also perceptive of the effects of JIS on them!
